COMICS AND GRAPHIC NOVELS HAVE BECOME MORE POPULAR THAN EVER, AND MANY ADVOCATES OF THE MEDIUM HAVE MAINTAINED THAT THEY DESERVE THE SAME MEASURE OF RESPECT ACCORDED TO OTHER, "LEGITIMATE" FORMS OF LITERATURE. TO DATE, HOWEVER, THERE HAVE BEEN NO DETAILED COMPARISONS BETWEEN COMICS AND THESE FORMS. REFLECT UPON AND EXPAND THE BOUNDARIES OF DIFFERENT
LITERARY FORMS. IN THE END, HE ARGUES CONVINCINGLY THAT
COMICS HAVE EARNED THE RIGHT TO BE REGARDED AS AN
IMPORTANT LITERATURE.
